**International Rectal Microbicide Advocates (IRMA)** is a global network numbering over **800** advocates, policymakers and leading scientists from **60+ countries on six continents** working to advance research, development and access to safe, effective, acceptable and accessible rectal microbicides - agents in the form of a gel, a lube, an enema or a suppository that could provide protection against HIV during anal intercourse - for the women and men around the world who need options beyond latex.

Since its creation in 2005, IRMA serves as a central forum for exchange, debate, and networking on rectal microbicides. Beyond its primary goal, the organization aims to support the research of other new prevention technologies, such as male circumcision, vaccines and oral prevention (PrEP), and to promote existing prevention methods such as male and female condoms as part of a range of prevention options.

- **Access** to the most recent information on the medical prevention of HIV, an online blog to connect with peers and experts, exchange advice and experiences and advance their understanding of the microbicides
- **Advocacy** opportunities to influence funders, policy makers, elected officials, and their government officials on rectal microbicides research and availability

- **Education** through the teleconferences and community presentations organized or supported by IRMA
- **Networking** with the world's leading scientists, advocates, policy makers who advance the research on rectal microbicides
